- Chamber music concert on 11th March (please applay for participation asap!) in August-Everding-Saal, Grünwald (Munich)
- Please book your journeys yourself (to and from): Arrival on 28th or 29th February (until 9:30 a.m.) in Munich, departure on 14th March in the morning from KASSEL
- Reimbursement of travel costs: Up to 100 € (modalities see "Orchestra Ethics")
- Accomodation: 29.02. 08.03. in Pielenhofen (former monastery) full board, 08.-12.03. private accomodation in the greater Munich area, 12.-14.03. in Penta-Hotel Kassel
- Concerts in Munich, Wolfratshausen and Kassel
- Application for new members is only possible if a proper suitable application video is sent (preferably via a link to youtube) alongside with the application form via e-mail.

Costs:

- There is no application fee.
- We are sorry that the following costs cannot be provided by the orchestra:
 - 1. Travel expenses that exceed 100 €
 - 2. Catering on the short trip to Regensburg in 05.03. in the evening
 - 3. Dinners during the stay in the private accommodation (also dependent on the accommodation) and after the concerts (08.-13.03.)
 - 4. All drinks except for water

- He is a member of the *Giardino String Quartet* and has taken part in various jazz and free-style improvisation projects.
- Stefan Hadjiev gave his debut as a soloist in Germany in May 2015, where he performed Shostakovitch's 2nd Cello Concerto with the State Orchestra of Kassel.
- o Stefan has been a constant member of the *International Mahler Orchestra* since 2011 and is its substitute cello-soloist.

General Information:

- Musicians living outside the MVV network area will receive a one-off reimbursement for travel expenses
 up to 100 € (29.02. arrival journey to Munich central station, 13./14.03. departure from Kassel Wilhelmshöhe) after presentation of the receipts.
 - Please note: the least expensive travel alternative must be chosen (for details see the orchestra ethics)
- Car drivers who live outside the MVV network area will receive a one-off reimbursement of € 0,15 per km(29.02. arrival journey to Munich central station, 13./14.03. departure from Kassel)
- The reimbursement will only be granted for receipts presented by 30.04.2016.
- The first week of rehearsals will take place in former **Pielenhofen Monastery** (close to Regensburg). Klosterstraße 10, 93188 Pielenhofen (http://www.herder-schule.eu)
- **DEPARTURE by bus to Pielenhofen** on **Montag, 29**th **February** already at **10.00 a.m.** at ZOB (Central Bus Station) of Munich Central Station (double-decker bus by *Efinger*).
- Thus, please book your journey to Munich already for the 28th if neccessary. It is possible to spend the night in private accommodations.
- In the first week in Pielenhofen there is full board.
- There is also a restaurant right next to the monastery where you can eat at your own costs (<u>www.klosterwirtschaft.de</u>).
- On the evening of 05th March, we're going on a short trip to Regensburg. There, whatever you consume is at your own costs.
- **RETURNING to Munich** on **Tuesday, 8th March** at **11 a.m.** after the breakfast, around 2 p.m. arrival in Munich ZOB, afterwards check-in of the private accomodations.
- In the private accomodation we unfortunately can only assure you bed and breakfast.

- The confirmation of participation will be sent out individually as soon as possible after all your application documents have been checked (important: audition video!)
 In case of cancellation of participation after the confirmation, an adequate substitute must be provided.
