## **Travel expenses**

Flight tickets Munich-China and China-Munich as well as visa for China will be provided.

For this project individual travel expenses will be refunded **up to 250,- €.** For this we need a copy of the ticket+bill. The refund will happen after the project. Tickets for train, flights and long-distance buses are reimbursed. If you arrive by car, a mileage allowance will be reimbursed against a fuel receipt. All participants have to take care to find the most inexpensive way to travel, as soon as they have got the final confirmation from NPhM. Travel expenses within the project, local public transport (e.g. tram) and Visa costs can't be refunded. The claim on reimbursement for travel expenses expires 6 weeks after the end of the project.
